Most outstanding activity and/or event that increases awareness of homeless veterans.

- Citation to every auxiliary that hosts an activity and/or event that increases awareness of homeless veterans. Citations will be mailed directly to the participating Auxiliaries from National Headquarters.
- Citation and \$25 to one Auxiliary in each of the four (4) Conferences with the most outstanding activity and/or event that increases awareness of homeless veterans. Winners will be announced and awards presented at the 2023 National Convention in Phoenix, Arizona.
