In recent years, there has been a resurgence of patriotic pride. The U.S. flag can be seen flying everywhere to indicate a symbol of unity. We need to remember the men and women serving in our military and to remember those who have died.

I would like to share a few guidelines.

- 1) A flag displayed on a car should be fastened to the right side bumper, antenna or window.
- 2) If on a wall, the blue field should be in the upper left corner, and it should NEVER touch the ground.
- 3) When displaying an all-weather flag outdoors, there should be a light near it at night, so it is not in complete darkness.
- 4) Above all, when a flag becomes worn, please replace it!!!!
