Who Can Enter? • Any student in grades 9-12 who is enrolled in a public, private, or parochial high school or homeschool program. • Maximum student age of 18 at time of local entry. Participants must submit entries to a sponsoring, participating VFW Auxiliary by March 31, 2024.

Continuing Education

- Open only to VFW Auxiliary members, their spouses, and children. • Qualifying member must have been a member for at least one (1) year. • The applicant must be at least 18 years of age. • There must be a financial need. • There are (4) \$1000.00 winners, one in each of the (4) Auxiliary Conferences.

- Scholarship application is due to National Headquarters by **February 15, 2024.**
