Hearing/speech paired students should email the Voice of Democracy National Office at youthscholarships@fw.org for special instructions. No music, singing, poetry, or sound effects are allowed.

The body of the essay <u>must not</u> identify the entrant in any way, (including, but not limited to name, school, city, state, race, or national origin).
