The Connecticut Coalition to End Homelessness (Veterans)

The Connecticut Coalition to End Homelessness, in partnership with members and communities throughout the state, creates change through leadership and advocacy. Their collective mission is to prevent and end homelessness in Connecticut.

While the State of Connecticut is slated to receive more than \$2B in ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act), neither Governor Ned Lamont, nor leaders of the legislature's Appropriations Committee, has included resources for homelessness in their allocation plans.

Advocates warn that if homelessness is left out of the ARPA negotiation, homelessness in communities across the state will drastically increase.
